- 1. Spectators may not enter horse/showing rings
- 2. Restricted areas in progress please adhere to health and safety notices
- 3. Children must be supervised at all times and kept a safe distance from vehicles and animals.
- 4. Animals must be controlled at all times, please keep dogs away from the horse arenas
- 5. Any person in charge of an animal who in the opinion of the judges, committee member, or Health and Safety officer is causing a disturbance or is a danger to the public in any way will be asked to remove the animal from the grounds.

- 6. Please park in designated areas only. This is a residential area please do not block gateways.
- 7. Please be aware that there is a canal and river in close proximity to the Show grounds, please keep children in sight at all times.
- 8. Amenities are used at own risk.
