### **Health and Safety Advice**

1. Spectators may not enter horse/showing rings
2. Restricted areas in progress – please adhere to health and safety notices
3. Children must be supervised at all times and kept a safe distance from vehicles and animals.
4. Animals must be controlled at all times, please keep dogs away from the horse arenas.
5. Any person in charge of an animal who in the opinion of the judges, committee member, or Health and Safety officer is causing a disturbance or is a danger to the public in any way will be asked to remove the animal from the grounds.

6. Please park in designated areas only. This is a residential area please do not block gateways.
7. Please be aware that there is a canal and river in close proximity to the Show grounds, please keep children in sight at all times.
8. Amenities are used at own risk.

You must present your entry receipt to collect prize monies. No receipt no prize. Prizes can be collected from the Marquee from 16:30 on. Prizes must be collected on the day.
